No movement of vehicles will be permitted after 8:30am unless under Show Society supervision and direction.

<b>Judging</b>	Judging will commence at 10am and times will be strictly adhered to.
<b>Waivers &amp; Declarations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● AgShows NSW Waiver must be completed</li><li>● National Sheep Health Declaration form must be completed</li></ul>
<b>Conditions of Entry</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● PIC NC045976</li><li>● Sheep exhibits will be watered free of cost to all exhibitors.</li><li>● Exhibitors will be required to provide fodder for their livestock</li><li>● EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: All rams exhibited must be from an accredited free flock, or a Veterinary Certificate indicating that (a) A manual examination and two negative compliment fixation tests for ovine brucellosis not less than 60 days apart, the second test being within 30 days of the show. (b) In his opinion there is no evidence of ovine brucellosis on the property. Must be presented to and cleared by the chief steward before rams are unloaded.</li><li>● All exhibits in this section must be certified to having been well and closely shorn.</li><li>● Exhibitors who cannot pen entries are specially requested to advise the Show Society so as to avoid inconvenience to Stewards in arranging pens.</li><li>● All sheep must be owned by their exhibitor three months before the show.</li><li>● Where applicable, exhibitors must state name of breeder at time of entry.</li><li>● The ages of sheep shall be determined by certificate.</li><li>● All sheep shall be eligible to compete for the championship prize of the several breeds.</li><li>● The judges shall have the power to disqualify or mark as disqualified any exhibit which in their opinion, does not comply with the regulations and shall enter the reason. In the event of any protest or disqualification being upheld the next in order shall take its place.</li><li>● Prime sheep and lambs to be judged on commercial value, unless otherwise stated.</li></ul>

- No one sheep or pens can be entered in more than one class excepting where specially mentioned.
- Sheep under 1 year not to show more than 2 teeth, sheep 1 year old and under 2 years not to show more than 4 teeth. Sheep entered in a class for which it is found they are not eligible owing to the above regulations shall be transferred to a class for which they are eligible. To be able to carry out these rules, judges are instructed to judge young sheep first.
- All Stud Merino and Corriedale entries to be shorn and date of shearing to be produced on request.
- In the Stud Section each owner's entries will be penned as a group and not in classes, It is necessary that competitors make their entries as early as possible to assist the Stewards.
- All sheep to be tagged with NLIS tags & be supported by a National Sheep Health Declaration
- Exhibits may be removed from the ground on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2023 from 9am. All movement of vehicles will be coordinated by the Chief Steward or under Show Society supervision and direction.
